Authorization for Change Form

What is CodeRED®?

The Community Emergency Notification System, called CodeRED®, is designed to provide a geographically selected group of phone numbers, automatically call each number, and provide a pre-corded voice message, text and/or email giving emergency instructions to whomever receives the message.

The system program uses an existing home phone database when contacting residents. However, after implementation, phone numbers for this database will NOT be automatically updated. If a resident or business moves or changes a phone number, you should

However, these phone numbers do not include cellular, text or email listings. Residents or businesses using these services and that wish to be notified through one of those media in an emergency must enter their information into the CodeRED® system. Additionally, a person or business that does not wish to be included in the Community Notification System may request that their number be removed from the database.
