COURSE DESCRIPTION: This 12-hour course was designed by the Ohio Fire Academy and the Fire Prevention Bureau for safety educators or fire investigators who have the responsibility to interview juvenile fire setters. Through group activities, students will learn to determine if the child's fire setting behavior can be treated through fire safety education, or it is a symptom of problems requiring referral program.

COURSE CONTENT: Characteristics of fire setting behavior for age groups 4-7, 8-11 and 12-14; interviewing techniques to classify fire setting behavior; and methods of establishing a community fire setter's referral program.
